FLOATS

These sturdy plastic floats are lightweight one-piece polyurethane mouldings. The patterned face is non-absorbent and is used for applying plaster, cement and other building materials.

The sponge float has a polyurethane backing and is used for finishing more grainy surfaces such as sand and cement mix, or for applying certain plaster finishes.

SCRATCHING TOOL

The thin wire prongs are used for scratching the first coat of plaster to provide a key which ensures the proper adhesion of the second or finishing coat.

The first coat is best scratched 'criss-cross fashion' before it has had time to fully harden.
