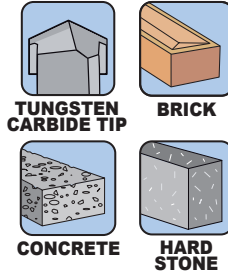


Standard Masonry Bits

Standard masonry bits are for use in chucks up to 13mm capacity and are suitable for general purpose drilling including bricks, blocks and cement render when used in an impact or percussion drill. Featuring a heavy-duty tungsten carbide tip and fast spiral for waste removal.
